- The role **leads the Competitive Programme team** as a role model for the Tri Star values, recruiting, retaining, developing and motivating a high-performing team while also identifying and supporting the future talent development for coaching and judging.
- The role is accountable for **establishing and delivering the programme budget and targeted financial and operational metrics**, in collaboration with the Finance and Operations Managers, providing regular performance reporting.
- The Competitive Programme Manager is a member of the Tri Star Senior Management Team accountable for driving the overall success of Tri Star with strong leadership skills and a passion for excellence in a high performing team environment.
