Awards:

Competition results will be available as soon as possible after each session. Medals will be awarded for team and individual placings as well as apparatus placings for 2 day competitions.

Certificates will be awarded for All Round and Apparatus Placings in Step 5-6 and Levels 4-6.

Teams:

Teams consist of 3-4 gymnasts. The top three scores count toward the team total. Please indicate your team(s) on the entry form.
